



AGREEMENT

The education agreement, as it appears below, is entered into by and between KMRIA, Inc. and the parent/student (client). Except as otherwise stated or modified on the face of this Agreement the following shall be the terms and conditions of the contract.

- (1) The client will be appropriately dressed.
- (2) Failure of the client to attend will result in a 50% charge for the time and services of the tutor.
- (3) The client will demonstrate discipline in both school work and in employment.
- (4) The school / KMRIA will supply the client all items necessary for the conduct of education. This shall include books, library materials, and articles necessary for the performance of the work. All of these materials will be returned at the conclusion of the academic work or a monetary sum will be attached in lieu of their return.
- (5) Liaison between the school and the tutor will be the responsibility of both the education establishment and the appointed instructor.
- (6) The client will be responsible to the customer, be it the school or the employer.
- (7) KMRIA guarantees that a representative of the company will be available to the client on an on-call basis during the academic year.
- (8) KMRIA will not be responsible for any misrepresentation of the academic work made by the client.
- (9) No amendments, modifications, termination, or waiver of any provisions of this Agreement nor consent to any departure by the client therefrom nor deviation from the terms and conditions, unless stipulated in the Agreement, shall in any event be effective unless the same shall be in writing signed by the client and the authorized KMRIA representative.
- (10) The client, in executing the Agreement, acknowledges the reading and understanding of the provisions of said contract and the terms and conditions of the same.
